**FROM THE FINANCIAL LEADERSHIP TEAM**- Good news....Union UCC is the recipient of a federal loan under the Paycheck Protection Program established under the recently passed CARES act. The intent of the Program is to help small businesses, including organizations like the church, to sustain their ongoing operations and keep their staff employed. Importantly, the act allows for a portion of the loan to be forgiven as long as the proceeds are used to cover eight weeks of payroll costs and other costs like utilities and rent. For Union UCC, it is estimated that approximately \$50,000 of the loan proceeds related to our payroll and utility costs **(about 70% of the total loan)** can be forgiven....a huge help in keeping our staff employed during these critical few months.

We are using postcards, emails, Facebook, and Sunday's online worship to help share information. We are also mailing the bulletin to those who might not be online.
