

LECTIO DEVINA

Names were important in the Ancient Near East. Names described attributes of the person to whom they were assigned and could be changed when an important occurrence shifted the story and the essence of a person. The psalmist often gives glory to "the name of God." And yet to name God is difficult for there is no one word that can describe the fullness of the Holy. In today's Lectio Divina passage, the psalmist describes the attributes of God for which praise is given: justice and compassion. This is unlike any other unfeeling, life-denying idol that claims to be a "god." This is a Holy Spirit that moves and breathes—not only in setting the beauty of creation in motion, but even now. It is an indescribable presence that warrants the simple description "Beautiful Name."

Psalm 135: 1-3; 13-21 (Inclusive Bible)

Alleluia! Praise the Name of YHWH—sing praise, you who serve the Most High,

who stand in the house of YHWH, in the courts of God's house!
Alleluia! God is good!
[Sing praises to God's name because it is beautiful!]
