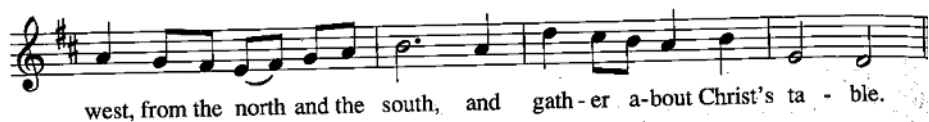
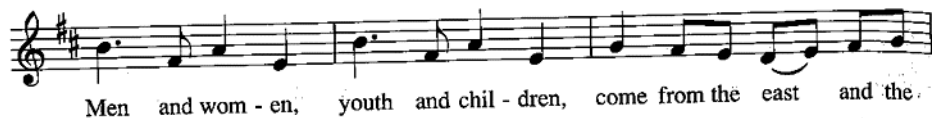
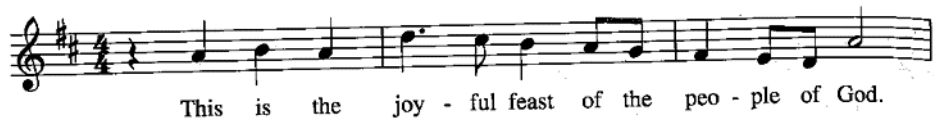

D May God be with you

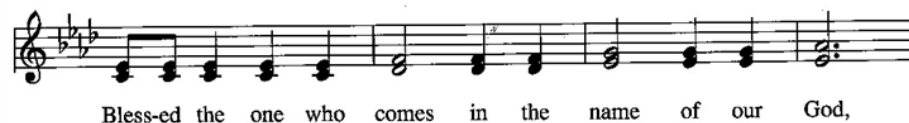
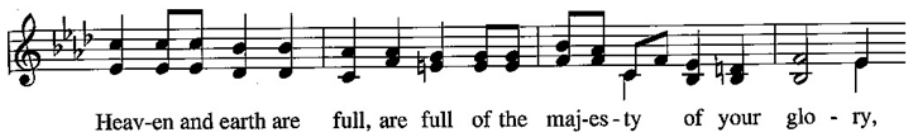
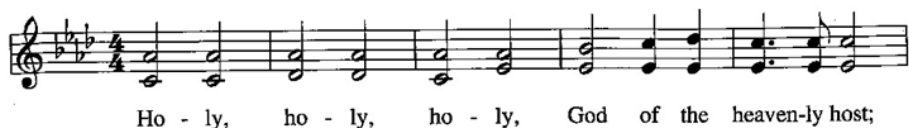
C And also with you!
