**Guest Speaker: Vicki Mayk, Union UCC Member and Author *Growing Up On The Gridiron: Football, Friendship and the Tragic Life of Owen Thomas***, chronicles the short but extraordinary life of a young man who grew up attending Union UCC. Owen was the son of our late pastor emeritus, the Rev. Thomas N. Thomas, and his wife, the Rev. Kathy Brearley. After his death by suicide in 2010, Owen's case became a significant part of the research that linked playing football with the traumatic brain condition CTE. The book tells the story of Owen, his family, teammates, friends, and coaches and explores the health concern he helped to illuminate. The book is also about the intoxicating nature of football culture in the United States, where the sport is a gift passed down from generations, fathers to sons, brother to brother. Few leave the game behind. Vicki Mayk has been a member of Union UCC since 2010. A former reporter for the *Pittsburgh Post-Gazette*, she has enjoyed a 35-year career in journalism and public relations. She has reported for newspapers in New Jersey and Pennsylvania and her work has appeared in national and regional magazines. She's been the editor of three university magazines, most recently at Wilkes University in Wilkes-Barre, Pa. She worked closely with the Thomas family and Owen's friends to write her book, which being published Sept. 1 by Beacon Press. Visit Amazon.com (and choose Union UCC as your charity on Amazon
