- 1. The **WISE** process, *Welcoming, Inclusive, Supportive* and *Encouraging* to individuals identified with mental illness, through the UCC. 2. Education around counseling guidance and resources for ongoing counseling. 3. Breaking down the silos between community services and the local church.
- 4. Advocating for individuals with mental health conditions. 5. Addressing veterans and moral injury. 6. Providing resources for conversation and worship, and 7. Suicide prevention education

Welcome to staff, Hannah and Ryleigh Minnich, who are now the sub.




HANNAH MINNICH
