

I am happy to report that the vote, by all (4) PA Conferences on Saturday, November 9, 2024, was positive for moving forward to merge into the Keystone Conference!! Each of the (4) Conferences vote was 90% or higher in the affirmative. We will be able to pool our financial resources, the proposed Keystone budget is slightly less than the total of all (4) Conference budgets combined, and we will be able to share human resources across the Commonwealth, each Conference has its own special gift to share.

The motion to become one Conference will be submitted to General Synod this summer for their approval. A Constitution and By-laws need to be drafted, transitional Board and staff will be put into place working up to the settled Board and staff. The plan is for the Keystone Conference to be operational on 01/01/2026! TOGETHER WE ARE STRONGER!!

The Union UCC logo development was informed by how members and leadership understand the church's identity, history, context, values, and goals, via interviews, a survey, and a site visit. Of particular significance were the terms "Relevant, Engaged, and Growing." Almost all survey respondents said being part of the United Church of Christ denomination is important to them. To subtly invoke UCC identity, the font and most of the color palette utilizes elements from the UCC brand standards. Additionally, the rainbow of colors suggests diversity/inclusion, as well as vibrant life. The primary symbol in the logo design is a tree with rainbow leaves. The tree suggests the church's growing nature, as well as providing a connection to the church's physical setting, especially the Grove. The "i" in Union forms the trunk of the tree, and its shape suggests a person with arms outstretched in praise and joy as well as welcome.




## No matter who you are, or where you are on life's journey, you are welcome here!
